Qualification

Delivery Method: Theory/practical

Prerequisites: Entry for these qualifications is available to any individual who is capable of achieving the required standard. Provider staff should understand the demands of these qualifications and match learners based on their individual capabilities and future progression requirements.

Before registering on this qualification you must have achieved the following:

Chainsaw Maintenance.

Cross-cut timber using a chainsaw.

Introduction

Prove your competence at felling trees up to 380mm with Lantra.

These qualifications are requirements for Professional Users to operate chainsaws in the UK.

Overview in brief

Our course is designed for anyone aged 16 or above.

You'll already have some experience of tree felling and processing.



You'll be able to provide evidence of your ability to meet licence to practice and/or other legal requirements.

And once the course is completed, you'll have the chance to obtain competency cards to boost your employment prospects.



For professional chainsaw operators working in forestry and arboriculture the industry recommendation is that for 'high risk' activities the minimum level of adequacy of training is to a certificate of competence or nationally recognised qualification where assessment is carried out independently of the training. **This qualification meets this requirement'**

The finer details

We use a balanced mix of theory and practical sessions to ensure you're working confidently to industry standards of good working practice.

You'll be given the chance to demonstrate your knowledge of, and competence in, the key skills of tree felling and processing.

Our course will also teach you to work safely across 23 guided learning hours.

Worth noting: As there are physical elements to our course, you'll need to have at least a minimum level of fitness.

Who should attend?
