- Experiencing and knowledge of all the equipment manoeuvrability
- Instruction as to the daily care of the vehicle



- Becoming familiar with the correct loading & unloading of the attachments onto the Multihog Vehicle
- Gaining a small amount of experience into the best usage of the Multihog vehicle
- Gaining experience for the best practices of the patch planer
- How to safely and correctly carry out a pre use check for both the machine and the patch planer
- Learn how to keep up the maintenance of both the Multihog and the patch planer

Who should attend?

Highways maintenance operatives will benefit from the training, especially those who are working within a patching team.

What will be covered?

By the end of the duration of the course, the learners will have the knowledge and guidance on how to safely operate the Multihog machine and also safely use the patch planer attachment within a live environment.
