

## Industry Accreditation (IA) – Interim Measures



### Renewal Blue FISS/CSCS – VRS Installers (permanent systems)

#### Interim Measures: **None. Current rules apply.**

1. CITB Operative Health, Safety and Environmental Test (or higher within 2 years of application)
2. Lantra Awards Health, Safety & Environmental Course - Fencing (or an equivalent within 2 years of application)
3. An in date VRS Installer course
4. An in date VRS Proprietary or NPSBS course

*Note: A Level 2 Diploma in Work-based Fencing – Vehicle Restraint Systems qualification will have already been achieved when applying for first Blue FISS/CSCS card.*

### Renewal IA Blue FISS/CSCS – VRS Installers (All Blue Cards)

1. CITB Operative Health, Safety and Environmental Test (or higher within 2 years of application)
2. Lantra Awards Health, Safety & Environmental Course - Fencing (or an equivalent within 2 years of application)

*Note: A VRS Installer will have already achieved the generic Foundation Course and generic Installer Course.*

#### Additionally (VRS Parapet Installer only):

3. An in date VRS Installer course
4. An in date VRS Parapet Proprietary course

#### Additionally (Temporary VRS only):

5. An in date Temporary VRS (TVRS) Proprietary course

#### Interim Measures:

1. A Parapet or Temporary VRS Installer can apply for an IA Blue FISS/CSCS Installers card, as long as they have met the training requirements above, up until the end of December 2024.
2. A new Level 2 Diploma in Work-based Fencing, to include pathways for Parapets and TVRS will be available for registration in Q3 or Q4 of 2024
3. IA card holders must enrol on the new qualification (when available) and apply for a new Experienced Worker FISS/CSCS card (Red), which will show all BLUE skills for a Parapet and/or TVRS installer
  - The Experienced Worker card is valid for 12 months (maximum **December 2025**), provided all the other training is in place
  - FISS/CSCS Experienced Worker card fee is £30+VAT
4. When the qualification has been achieved the Experienced Worker can apply for a Blue FISS/CSCS Installers card; Valid for 5 years, fee £30+VAT
5. An Installer holding a VRS or General Fencing qualification can upgrade to Parapets / TVRS by achieving the additional units only
6. For those Blue, Gold & Black FISS/CSCS card holders that have Parapet and/or Temporary VRS IA skills meeting the above requirements, can apply to have an Experience Worker category added to their card for £20+VAT and then add Parapet and/or Temporary VRS Installer for £20+VAT once the qualification is complete.
