

Lantra News Update: NHSS Card Checker

Lantra would like to notify the NHSS Training Provider network that we are making changes to our internal processes, this is to ensure we are spending our time on quality verification, registering Learner courses and dispatching cards within the turn a-round times.

In making these changes to streamline our internal processes, as of Monday 31st August, Lantra will cease to e-mail Gencarda reports after each Learner registration.

Instead of the Gencarda report, NHSS Training Provider Managers will be issued with a confirmation email containing the Learners name and Lantra unique ID number. From the confirmation email, the Training Provider can locate and download Learner details from the CITB card checker.



The card checker function has been running since March 2020 and has been well received by industry as a means to check Learners skills quickly without the need to physically scan a card.

The following steps show you how to use the card checker website.

Step	Info	Visual Guide
1.	Enter the CSCS Website	https://gosmart.co.uk/
2.	Locate the Online Card Checker Button	
3.	Read the Terms and Conditions for using the Online Card Checker. Click Accept and Continue.	
4.	Click on "Change Scheme", a drop down list of all the CSCS associated schemes will appear, scroll down until you find the "NHSS Temporary Traffic Management" selection. Or "FISS" if you want to check a NHSS 10B card	
5.	Enter the registration number and surname of the card holder. This will show you an electronic copy of the card holders NHSS card.
